The Sheriff Youth Week program offers a unique opportunity for young people to explore interests in law enforcement through police academy-style training, physical fitness and instructional sessions.

Sheriff Youth Week is being held July 9 – 13, 2012 from 7:45 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. daily. Each day's session begins and ends with one hour of rigorous exercise and drill. Each recruit will receive a certificate from the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office upon completion of the academy. Recruits are taught by municipal, county, state and federal law enforcement agencies.

Sheriff's Youth Week is free of charge and applications are accepted from Monmouth County high school-aged student (graduated 8th grade going into high school, in high school or just graduated from high school). *Anyone interested in participating must return an application and signed permission slip with completed physical form to the Sheriff's Office no later than June 10, 2012.
